ABOUT KANSAS HUNTING

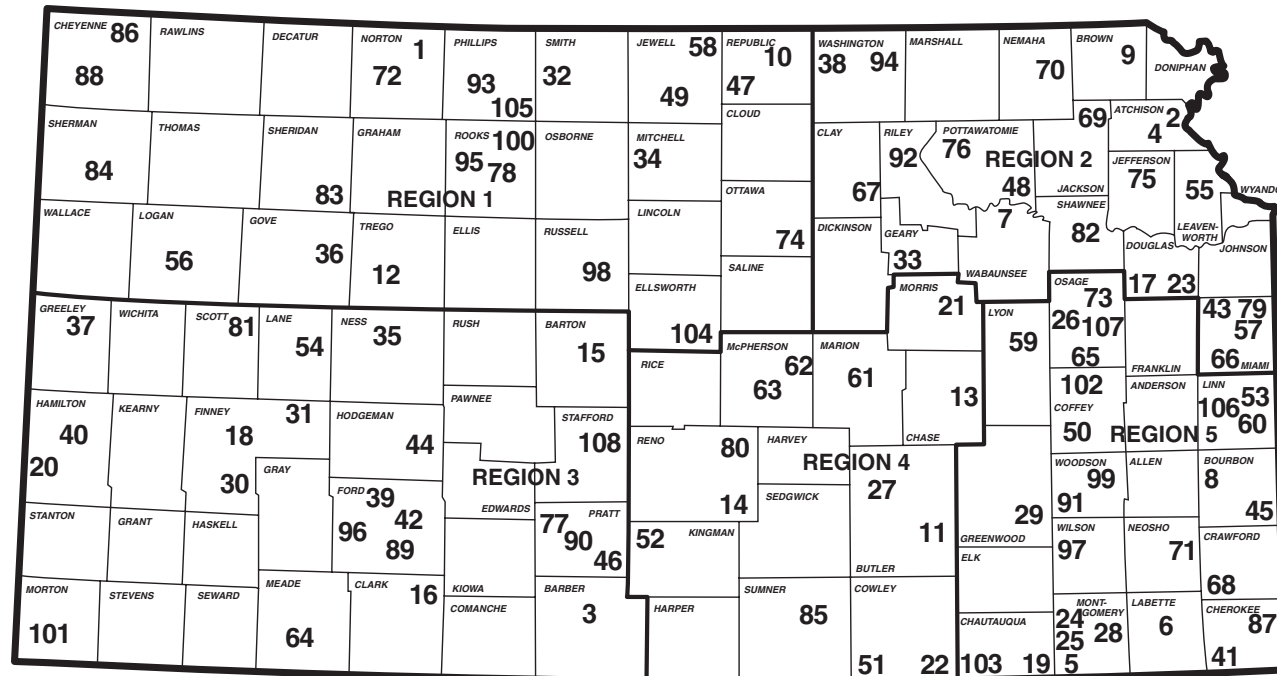
Most hunting in Kansas is done on private land, and you must have permission before hunting on any private land, posted or not. The only exception is the Walk-In Hunter Access land. It's a good idea to make contact with landowners well before the season, but if you cannot, locate a public hunting area and base your hunt there. Once you become familiar with the region, you can become acquainted with local landowners and get permission to hunt.

The Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks manages more than 200,000 acres for public hunting. There are 90 separate areas scattered across the state. All are free to licensed hunters during open seasons. Hunting pressure will be greatest during the first weekend of the season, but hunters can often find uncrowded, quality hunting later in the season.

All waterfowl hunting in Kansas requires non-toxic shot. In addition, Cheyenne Bottoms, Benedictine Bottoms, Isabel Wetlands, Jamestown, Marais des Cygnes, McPherson Wetlands, Neosho, Otter Creek, Texas Lake, Slate Creek, and Wild Turkey Playa wildlife areas, as well as Flint Hills, Kirwin, Marias de Cygne and Quivira National Wildlife refuges require non-toxic shot for all shotgun hunting.

Hunting blinds or stands must be portable or temporary and removed at the end of the season. Temporary blinds for waterfowl must be made of natural materials found at the site. Digging pit blinds is prohibited.

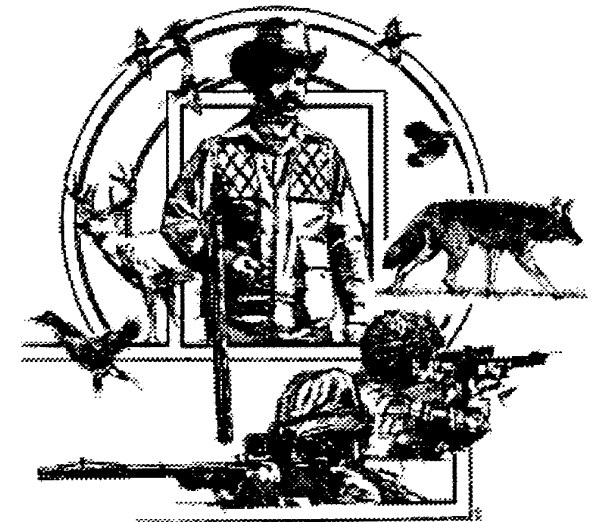
